Mr. Scott Owens began his career in law enforcement with the United States Army where he served six (6) years on active duty with the Military Police. His duty assignments included the Federal Republic of Germany and the United States Military Academy at West Point, New York.

After leaving active military service Mr. Owens (Scott) joined the United States Park Police in Washington, D.C. He worked in Washington, D.C. and Maryland as a federal law enforcement officer for three (3) years before leaving to pursue a college degree.

Mr. Owens (Scott) left Washington, D.C. for central Kentucky to study forensic science at Eastern Kentucky University where he earned a Bachelor's Degree in 1998.

After graduation Mr. Owens (Scott) was hired by the Department of Criminal Justice Training in Richmond, Kentucky as a law enforcement training instructor.
